

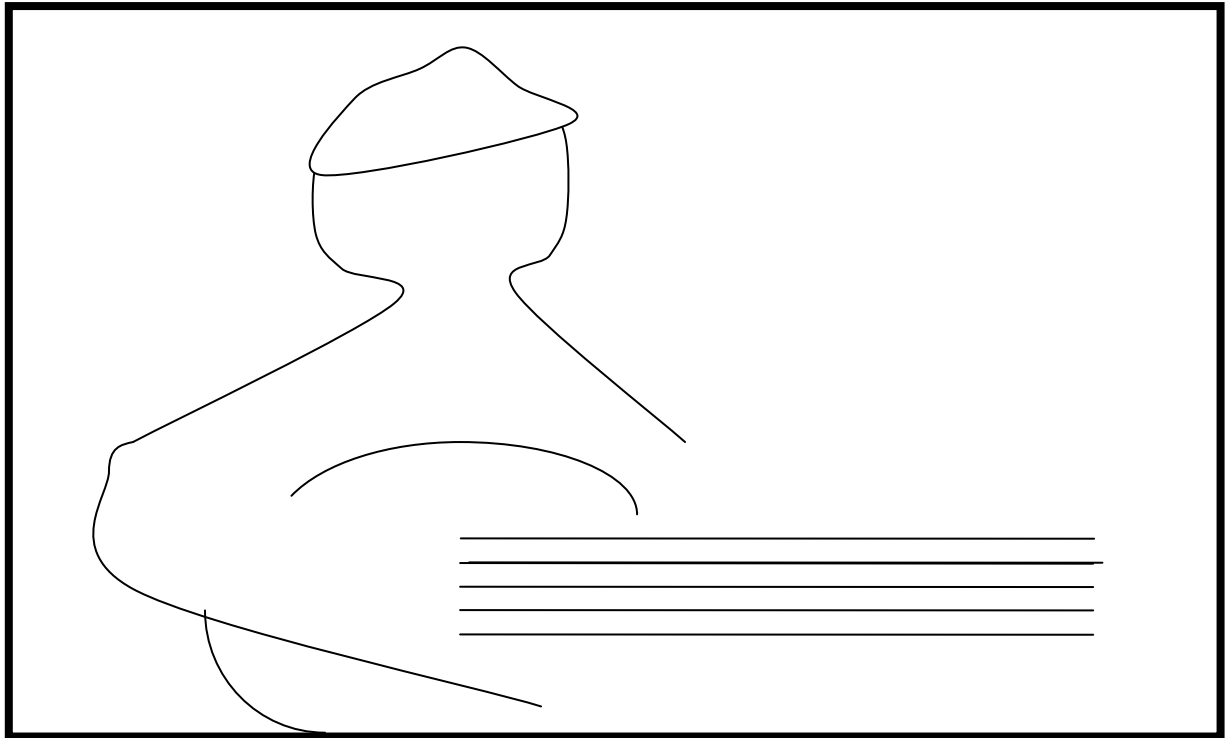
## John 7:37-39                      Streams of Life-Giving Water

<sup>37</sup> On the last and most important day of the festival, Jesus stood up and shouted, “If you are thirsty, come to me and drink! <sup>38</sup> Have faith in me, and you will have life-giving water flowing from deep inside you, just as the Scriptures say.”

<sup>39</sup> Jesus was talking about the Holy Spirit, who would be given to everyone that had faith in him. The Spirit had not yet been given to anyone, since Jesus had not yet been given his full glory. (CEV)

*Complete the picture below to show an aspect of the life-giving water.*

*This life-giving water had not been given until Pentecost when God poured out his Spirit on his people. The water is a symbol of a quenched thirst. If you are searching deeply for God to direct your life, just simply pray and have faith that God will keep his promises.*
