The Prayer Vine.

What a great privilege it is to belong to a fellowship where we can show our love and care for one another by upholding one another in prayer, especially in times of need- and also to pray for other people outside our fellowship who ask for prayer.

Most of our congregation do this from time to time as it is a vital element of sharing the love of God with others.

However the "Prayer Vine" was set up many years ago to intentionally pray regularly for those who request it, and so to enrich the prayer life of our church and bring God's blessing to many.

How does it work?

You might be going through a bad time due to illness or stress, then you can phone the Prayer vine convenor, and he/she passes on your request for prayer to the others who participate, and they undertake to pray for you regularly for a week or two – or longer if need be. You can ask for any degree of confidentiality you may desire.

Or maybe there is a family member or friend who needs God's help for some reason, you can pass their request on to the team, with whatever amount of confidentiality is desired,

At present there are about 12 people who share in this ministry of our church, and we would love to include others. If you feel that you would like to participate, please the contact the convenor. This year, as for many years now, we know that many people have experienced God's love and healing through this ministry.


PRAISE AND PRAYER
